

Apprenticeship Report

Year Ending March 2023



Introduction

The Public Sector Apprenticeships target came to an end on 31 March 2022. From 1 April 2022 there is no longer a target for public sector employers. However, employers who have gathered data historically are asked to continue to gather and report on:

- Number of new apprentices in the period.
- Total number of apprentices employed.
- Establishment headcount on the previous 31 March
- Establishment headcount in the current year as at 31 March
- Apprentices as a percentage of headcount as based on the previous year

The period means the 12 months between 1 April and 31 March in a reporting year.
